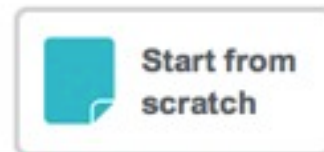

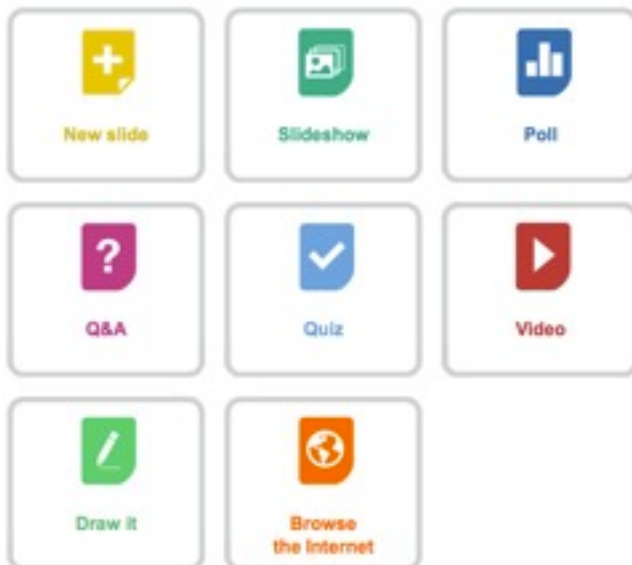

Step 7a: Insert Slide



This feature allows you to add a slide such as the 'Learning Objective' for that lesson. This slide is not interactive.

Step 7b: Insert Slideshow



This features allows you to add multiple pictures. This could used in a unit such as *landforms* where you can show a variety of landforms in the different categories. This slide is not interactive.

Step 7c: Insert Poll



Survey questions where there is no option for correct/incorrect answers. This is interactive.

Step 7d: Q & A



This enables you to get a real time check for understanding.

Step 7e: Quiz



Instead of a single question, have students answer a series of questions at their own pace.

Step 7f: Video



There is still no way to directly download Youtube videos to Nearpod. See separate HELP for more information.

Step 7g: Draw it



Have students draw over a blank canvas or over an image. Choose which ones to share with the group.

Step 7h: Browse the Internet



Share web pages with users.

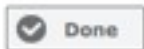


Look for the settings icon to add even more customization to your interactive features. Example: You can add a reference image for question or have short answer responses instead of multiple choice questions.
